## MISSION—MARSABIT

Since 2012, St. Paul's Summerville has developed an increasingly closer connection with the Diocese of Marsabit in Northern Kenya, supporting construction projects, sending a small mission team, and receiving on several occasions Bishop Rob Martin and Bishop Qampicha Wario to teach and minister among us. The Lord has truly blessed these relationships and, what is more, has expanded them to other parts of the Diocese of South Carolina. The Diocese of Marasabit now has significant ministry partnerships with three other churches in South Carolina not to mention several budding relationships in which the Lord is

just beginning to do His work. Out of that, at least four churches have been built, rectories completed, and dirt bikes purchased – all for the sake of the spread of the Gospel! For St. Paul's part, construction has been recently completed on a rectory that we funded for the priest in Sololo, right next to the Kenya/Ethiopia border.



I'm excited to share today that funds have been raised for two more projects, one of which is soon to be completed while the other is soon to be begun. Through your generosity at God's Gift Shop in December, money was raised to complete a Mother's Union guesthouse in Sololo. This building, 75% of which is funded solely by the working women in Kenya, will provide a source of

income for the Mother's Union and support for missionaries and guests in Sololo. It is a project that has been in construction for several years, built piece by piece as money was available, that is finally on the way to completion!

Even more significantly, St. Paul's has raised enough money to build a building in Walda to support Christians there. In this primarily Muslim community, the church will now have an opportunity, with its new building, to offer kindergarten classes to the children of Walda and also have a place of worship on Sunday mornings. This is a significant outreach opportunity as Kenyan parents typically do not allow religious affiliation to prevent them from sending their children to a quality school. What an opportunity we have to reach Muslim families through their children, as well as strengthen the faith of Christians in this community!

I remain thankful for this significant, growing partnership that St. Paul's and the Diocese of South Carolina share with the Diocese of Marsabit. It is clear to me that God's kingdom is establishing a stronghold in a strategic part of the world and I'm thankful that we've been invited to play a part in it!

## General Information for this morning

**Welcome** to St. Paul's! We hope to create an atmosphere in which everyone feels welcomed with open arms. Here is the information that you need to know for a successful morning of worship and Sunday School:

- **Worship as a Family (all ages):** At St. Paul's, we encourage families to worship together on Sunday mornings, therefore children in first grade and older will remain with their parents throughout the service. If you or your children are not used to this, please know that we understand and recognizing that it might take a few times to develop the routine. We're here to help, so don't hesitate to ask a priest or our Children's Minister about successful family worship. *If you need to take your children out of the service for a moment (we know, temper tantrums happen!), please feel free to:*
  - ☛ In Doar Hall, go to the Atrium (to your left) or St. Paul's central (to your right)
  - ☛ In the Church Building, go to the Family room behind the choir area (front left).

- **Kid's Church (3 years old through Kindergarten):** Children who wish to go to Kid's Church will leave the service after the Gospel is read and return for Holy Communion. While away, they will participate in a liturgy that mirrors that of the church service, including a Bible teaching at their level, song, prayers, and confession.

- **Nursery: Infant (6 – 17 months) and Toddler (18 months – 3 years)** are located on the first floor of the Children/Youth Building. Our experienced staff is CPR and First Aid certified and pagers are provided to notify parents if necessary.

**Communion**—anyone baptized in the Christian faith is welcome to receive communion this morning. **Please note:** the Communion elements consist of real wine and bread or wafers containing wheat. Please ask the bread server for gluten free wafers. Receiving one or the other is considered participating as fully as anyone who receives both.

All guests are invited to visit our **Welcome Table** after the service today. You will receive a gift and information about St. Paul's.

**Giving**—Cash and checks may be placed in the offering plates. We also have an electronic giving center in Doar Hall for debit and credit cards. St. Paul's does not want anyone to incur debt in order to give to the Lord. We offer the electronic giving centers as a convenience.
