A History Of St. Paul's Church

St. Paul's Summerville began in the 1800's as a church which drew from surrounding parishes of St. Paul's Stono. In 1829, the Reverend Philip Gadsden held regular summer services, and in 1839 the first building was built near the current site. In 1855 the congregation was incorporated as St. Paul's Summerville, and in 1857 the present building was consecrated. Over the years the building has been enlarged and renovated.

Today, St. Paul's embraces a vision being **rooted** in the past, yet relevant today: St. Paul's **Sows** the Good News of Jesus for all People, **Cultivates** servant leaders, and **Grows** neighborly communities The vision is a call to be disciples of the Gospel.


